OWN RISK**

VILLAGE OF ORTONVILLE  
**SKATE PARK**  
SAFETY AND CONDUCT RULES

*As Revised July 1, 2011*

- 1. All skaters must have a signed liability waiver on file with The Village of Ortonville. Participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian sign the waiver in the presence of a notary public. Ages 8 and under must be accompanied in the park by parent or legal guardian. *(Will be initiated later this season)***
- 2. Skateboards and skating allowed in designated areas only. Only one person per skateboard. You must skate safely and remain in control at all times. All participants are responsible for avoiding collision with others. No personal ramps permitted, and no bystanders allowed in skating area. All skaters and bystanders must follow all posted park rules.**
- 3. A shirt and shoes must be worn at all times when using the skate park. Skateboards must be in good working condition. BMX bikes are permitted in good working condition.**
- 4. No food, drink or chewing gum may be brought into the skating area. No glass containers allowed. The use of alcohol or tobacco products of any type is prohibited at all locations within the Skate Park. No drugs are allowed at any time, and will result in immediate expulsion from The Village of Ortonville Skate Park.**
- 5. Gear and clothing not in use must be stored outside of the skate area. Non-skate related gear is not allowed in the skating area.**
- 6. Other than for special events sanctioned by The Village of Ortonville, contests or other competitions are prohibited.**
- 7. Fighting, profanity or any other disruptive behavior is strictly prohibited. Staff members have the discretion to identify unwarranted conduct as necessary to ensure that participants, attendees, and Staff have an enjoyable park experience. Reckless or dangerous skaters will be requested to leave the skating area and premises immediately.**
- 8. The Village of Ortonville reserves the right to cancel any membership at any time or eject anyone for any reason without refund. *(Will be initiated later this season)***
- 9. Skaters are responsible for arranging for their own pick-up and/or transportation from The Skate Park property upon closure of the park, whether for inclement weather, normal park hours, or early closure for any reason.**
- 10. Skating permitted only during designated hours. Skate Park is closed during inclement weather, or no monitor present.**
- 11. All injuries must be reported to the Village of Ortonville on sight monitor who will call 911.**
- 12. Have fun, be courteous, obey all Staff Members, and skate safely!!**
