3. What are the key aspects or components of parks in Brandon/Ortonville that you feel should be preserved and maintained?

4. Currently, what is missing from the Brandon/Ortonville parks? (either missing altogether or missing in specific geographic areas of the community)

5. Are specific parks/facilities in need of repair or improvements? What types of improvements do they need and how would these improvements help your use of the park?

6. How can Brandon Twp. and The Village of Ortonville partner with your group or others to use, improve and maintain the park and recreational services? Please suggest new opportunities for co-use or programming of specific facilities.

7. In 20 years, what do you envision for the Brandon/Ortonville Parks system?

8. Are there any additional recreational programs you would like to see implemented in the Brandon/Ortonville area?
